V.Scott Solberg, PhD is Professor in the Department of Counseling and Human Development and Associate Dean for Research at Boston University's School of Education.

Throughout his career, Dr. Solberg has focused on designing and implementing career development programs and activities in college and k-12 settings. Current grant funded projects include an IES sponsored project designed to facilitate college and career readiness related research among districts and city government and a project sponsored by the Department of Labor to study national practices and policies concerning career readiness and use of individualized learning plans.

Past accomplishments include directing a large scale effort to localize a career information system in Singapore as well as creating a research-based resiliency curriculum – Success Highways –that is being used in schools throughout the United States.

He is an active member in the Society for Vocational Psychology, a Section in Division 17 (Society for Counseling Psychology) of the American Psychological Association. He is also a member of International Association for Educational and Vocational Guidance and the National Career Development Association.
